



Criteria for the Recognition of Outgoing Chairpersons

Description

A Certificate of special recognition is granted by the Council to an Actuary who has made a significant contribution to the actuarial profession at the international level as Chairperson of an IAA entity other than the Council.

Criteria

The Actuary has been appointed and served as Chairperson of an IAA Committee, Subcommittee, Section, Task Force or Working Group other than in an interim capacity.

Recognition

Recognition is by award of a Certificate expressing the gratitude of the Council for services rendered as Chairperson.

Recipients are identified in listings of IAA members and the presentation of the award is reported in the Newsletter.

Recipients who have served as Chair for a period of 3 years or more, and who are not recipients of any other IAA pin of recognition, also receive a pin representing the IAA logo.

Process

The Secretariat will include on the agenda of the last Council meeting prior to the completion of the mandate, the names of the proposed recipients, the entity they have chaired and the period during which services have been rendered. The presentation will take place at the time of approval by the Council or at a subsequent meeting attended by the recipient.
