2007 ASTIN Colloquium Call for Papers

Instructions for Authors

- Papers should be written in English or in French.
- Papers must be between 5 and 30 pages in length. These page limits include graphs, tables, appendices, endnotes and bibliographies. Notes to text should be endnotes rather than footnotes.
- The first page of the paper should include the title, details of the author(s), including name(s), professional affiliation(s), address(es), telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address(es), an abstract in either English or French, and keywords. The topic of the paper should also be included. If the paper is not on a topic in the provided list of topics, indicate "Other" and the subject of the paper.

For help with selecting keywords, authors may wish to refer to the <u>taxonomy of casualty actuarial science</u> developed by the Casualty Actuarial Society.

The following shows the preferred format for the first page:

Title of paper

Topic of paper (from Topic list if possible)

Family name, First name

Organization

Address

Telephone (including country + area code)

Fax (including country + area code)

E-mail address

Abstract

Keywords

- Papers should be submitted electronically as a PDF file or a Microsoft Word file. We
 would prefer to receive the paper in both formats. Submissions should be attached to an email.
- We recommend the following format: the paper should have a 1" (2.54 cm) margin at the top and bottom and on both sides. The font should have the size 12pt with single or 1.5 line spacing. A serif font, such as Times New Roman, is suggested. Endnotes should have the size 10pt.
- All mathematical symbols must be produced using a mathematical text-software. The recommended software is Microsoft Word (recent versions). The ASTIN Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject any paper that will not afford good-quality reproduction. We have provided detailed instructions for embedding fonts in Word [embedfonts.pdf] so that resulting PDF files are of high quality.
