- Professionalism is part of the actuarial education to become member of DAV since 2006
 - Today: Obligatory one day course (without exam) on
 - History, statutes and governance of DAV
 - Code of conduct
 - Professional standards of practice
 - Disciplinary code
 - Actuarial key functions in Germany / Europe
 - Case study on ethical behavior
 - Activities within DAV

Project: Education 2018

- DAV is currently reviewing its education and examination requirements
- New regulations will come into force starting 2018
- DAV's new basic knowledge is in line with the IAA Education Syllabus requirements (new syllabus from 2016)
 - This includes a course on professionalism (without exam)

Education in Professionalism (from 2018)

- The new one day course (also obligatory) will deal with the following topics:
 - Professional rules and actuarial behavior (incl. Code of Conduct, Actuarial Standards, importance of public interest)
 - Application of professional actuarial rules (incl. conflict of interest, documentation, Peer Review)
 - Case studies
