

## **SOCIAL SECURITY COMMITTEE REPORT FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 2004 – MAY 2005**

### **The Social Security Network**

The Committee has continued its work on establishing the Social Security Actuary's Network. The Network will be available on the IAA website and will provide a forum for actuaries to get in contact with local specialists as well as information on social security in each country. A template for country descriptions has been prepared and 11 countries have already provided information of their countries. The IAA secretariat has started the work to establish the web site and the first draft is available for the committee to discuss at the Rome meeting.

### **Participation in ICA-2006**

The committee has offered to organize four sessions in Paris Congress. A draft program has been prepared and will be discussed in Rome. The proposed program contains several topics from perspectives to social security reforms, financing and sustainability of social security systems to risk bearing.

### **The Role of the Actuary**

Several papers on the role of the actuary in social security are being developed. These papers will also be included on the Network.
