Jackie and JFK spent many years living in several quaint Georgetown homes - near both their families. The Kennedy's particularly spent many years living in several locations throughout Georgetown. As a bachelor and young congressman, JFK rented a variety of houses and later settled with Jackie into one of the most historic homes in the neighborhood. Your walking tour will touch on other Kennedy's who nested here and note where the clan ate and shopped.

After her husband's tragic assassination, Jackie was committed to living in Georgetown with her children, until finally leaving the small neighborhood when tourists and photographers camped outside her door nearly 24 hours a day. The tour will stop at this home and explore her surroundings and lifestyle during this tumultuous time.

Today, Georgetown is a neighborhood of powerful politicians and well-connected Washingtonians. Your GEP Washington tour guide will offer details on Georgetown's rich architecture and early history, explaining why people were drawn to the area.

After touring, you will have time to explore Georgetown's shopping scene and lunch on your own. Georgetown has always been known for its trendy and glamorous shops, streets and famous residents. There are countless shopping opportunities along several blocks of M Street and Wisconsin Avenue, including designer boutiques, specialty shops, and clothing stores. Everything from haute couture to second-hand kitsch!

From its roots as Centre Market, a fresh food venue born over 200 years ago, it's been a great unifier for DC – connecting people from a variety of backgrounds. From cupcakes, to wine and cheese pairings, to a classic soda shop, Union Market has something for everyone.
