

Role of IAA Delegates to Outside Organizations and Sections

- Appointments are made by Council on the recommendation of the Nominations Committee
- Terms of office are for three years and subject to reappointment by Council
- An individual shall not serve more than two consecutive terms of office for the same section
- Delegate can be nominated to more than one organization or section
- Delegate should not be an elected member to the Committee of the section or organization in to which he/she is appointed
- Delegate represents the IAA and its policies at relevant meetings, chairs the election process of sections and ensures continuity
- Delegate reports to responsible committee on developments within the section (Member Services Committee) or organization (appropriate designated committee within IAA, for example, for IAIS to Insurance Regulation Committee)
- Delegate assumes his/her own expenses

I see some motivation to continue appointing delegates. They may provide continuity across changes in committees that may be very dependent on a few individuals. They play the role of an independent member and ensure the section is paying attention to the other sections and to the whole IAA structure
