# CIA International Activities

- ▶ CIA Board appoints
  - ▶ Committee on International Relations (CIR)
- ▶ Four subcommittees of CIR
  - ▶ International Accounting and Actuarial Standards
  - ▶ International Insurance Regulations
  - ▶ International Pension and Employee Benefits Standards
  - ▶ CIA Participation to IAA



# CIR Participation to IAA Subcommittee

- ▶ Comprises all CIA appointed delegates to IAA committees plus other CIA representatives
- ▶ Meets prior to, at and following IAA Committee meeting
- ▶ IAA Committee openings are advertised to CIA members
  - ▶ CIR interviews applicants and makes recommendation to CIA Board



# Prior to IAA Meetings

- ▶ Conference call several weeks before IAA
  - ▶ March 7 for Washington
- ▶ Agenda:
  - ▶ CIA Coverage at IAA meetings
  - ▶ Anticipated IAA topics of broad interest
  - ▶ Possible votes by CIA delegates



# At IAA Meeting

- ▶ Breakfast or lunch meeting
  - ▶ Updates after the planning call
- ▶ Subcommittee members fill in template following their session(s)
  - ▶ Submit to subcommittee chair



# Reporting Template

- ▶ Name of Committee
- ▶ Major issues discussed
- ▶ Key outcomes
- ▶ Relevance to the CIA
- ▶ Action required by the CIA
- ▶ Future issues to be addressed
