



**Minutes  
of the First General Meeting of  
the IAA Life Section**

Thursday, 1 June 2006

The first General Meeting of the Life Section was held at the ICA 2006 in Paris on Thursday, 1 June 2006 at 8.30 a.m.

The meeting was chaired by Peter Clark, President Elect of the IAA.

**1 Chairman's report**

Kurt Wolfsdorf summarised the mission, the goals and the topics of the new Life Section and gave an overview over planned activities (see Annex 1).
