



Minutes of the second annual general meeting of the IAA Life Section

Monday, 11th June 2007

The second general meeting of the IAA Life Section was held in Stockholm on Monday the 11th June 2007 at 17.15

The meeting was chaired by Kurt Wolfsdorf

1 Opening of meeting

Kurt Wolfsdorf welcomes the participants and opens the meeting.

2 Minutes from the first general meeting

The minutes of the first general meeting were approved without amendment.

3 Secretary's report

Malcolm Campbell presented a secretaries report.

Since the last AGM the committee has met five times (either in person or by telephone). Discussions have primarily concentrated on the organisation of seminars and colloquia; cooperation with the ASTIN Bulletin; and the provision of internet services.

The first IAA Life Section seminar took place in Mexico City on the 19th of April and was attended by over 200 participants. The first colloquium is at present taking place in Stockholm. The committee has confirmed that the second colloquium will take place in Quebec June 2008.

Cooperation with the ASTIN Bulletin has been further discussed, and the Bulletin is now open for contributions in the field of Life insurance. Members of the Life Section should now be receiving copies of the Bulletin.

Provision of internet services is under development.

At the last count the number of members was 811 and increasing.

4 Treasurer's report

The treasurer was not able to attend the meeting and no report was given.

Kurt Wolfsdorf informed the meeting that the finances of the section were in good shape as the membership was higher than budgeted for, and so far expenditure has been limited.

5 Membership fees 2008

The meeting approved membership fees for 2008 of CAD 40 (unchanged)

6 Election of committee members

There were no vacancies for new committee members and so no elections were required

7 Future colloquia and other activities

The next colloquium is planned to be in Quebec, 16th-19th June 2008.

The meeting approved a colloquium to be held in Munich 2009 (final dates to be advised later)

8 Other business

Andrew Cairns, the Editor of the ASTIN Bulletin, informed the meeting about the journal and encouraged participation by members of the section

Kurt Wolfsdorf informed the meeting of the committee's decision to give a prize for the best article published in the ASTIN Bulletin and concerning Life topics.

9 Next meeting

The next general meeting will take place in Quebec during the 2008 colloquium

Kurt Wolfsdorf declared the meeting closed.
