This notice describes the simple process for nominating yourself, or any other LIFE Member, to serve on the Committee.

The LIFE Committee consists of up to fourteen members. Two members, Stuart Wason (Canada) and Lars Pralle (Germany) are IAA delegates appointed by the IAA Executive Committee. The remainder of the Committee Members are elected by the Section membership, at an AGM, for a term of 4 years. Six (6) of these elected Committee Members are in the midst of their elected terms and will continue to serve on the Committee, until the year indicated below:
