AIRPORT TRANSFERS:

The safest methods of transportation to get to the hotel is with an authorized taxi or a private car service.

- Taxis (most economical method): taxi services are located at the international and domestic entrances at Terminals 1 and 2. In both cases, taxi tickets are sold at the outlets located near the arrival gates and in the walkway area. In order to purchase the appropriate taxi ticket, please note that the distance travelled between the airport and the Sheraton Maria Isabel Hotel is approximately 15 kilometers for a 25-minute drive.
