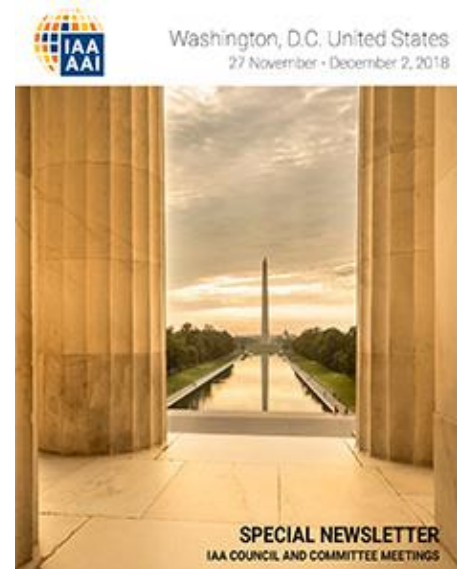

To apply for a Visa, please complete the "Applicant" portion of the [online application form](#) and submit it to our host association, [Institute of Actuaries of Japan \(IAJ\)](#), along with the required documents. Please note that the form

must be completed electronically; handwritten applications will be denied. Upon receipt of your application, the IAJ will complete other documents and will return them to you, scanned originals in color with signature and stamp, via email. Please note that the photo will only be required when submitting the final documents to the embassy.

The application procedure will take time. For this reason, the IAJ recommends that IAA Delegates send the documents as soon as possible and NO LATER than end of August.
