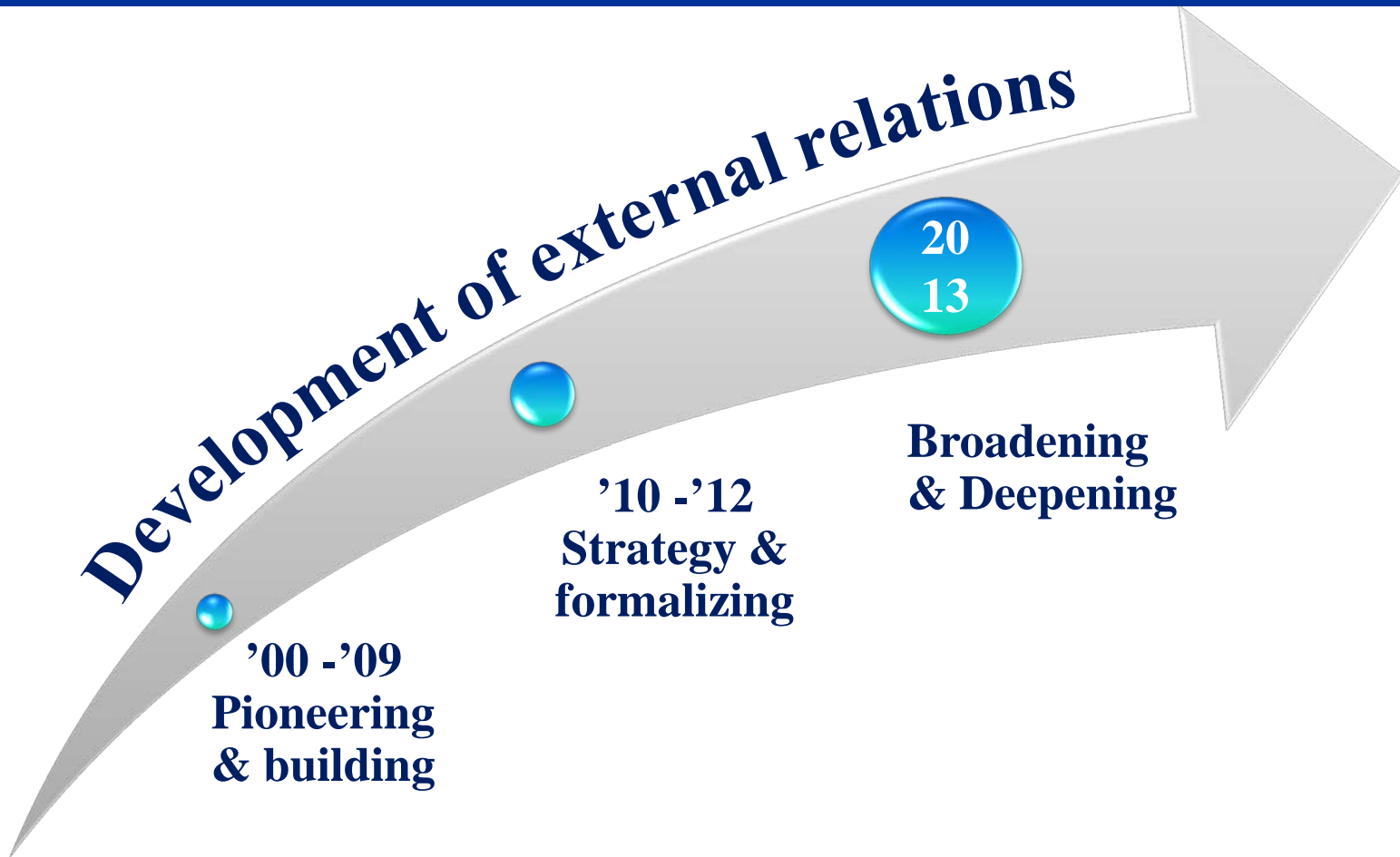

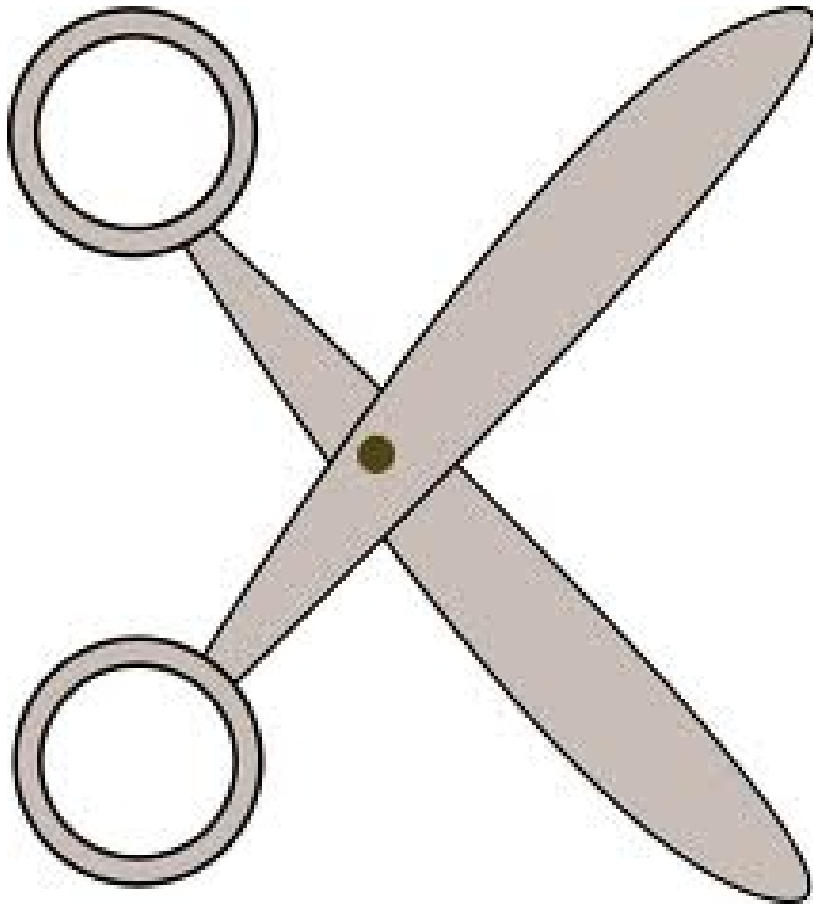

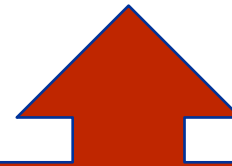
Our strategy: A pair of scissor's
