Earlier this week, Bozena and Mathieu also attended the Casualty Actuarial Society's Annual Conference.



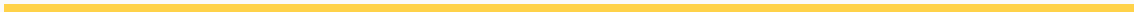
17th Asia Task Force Regional Seminar – Hong Kong

The IAA's Asia Task Force organized the 17th Asia Regional Seminar on October 22nd at the Ocean Park Marriott Hotel in Hong Kong immediately before the Asian Actuarial Conference.

The event, organized with the support of the Actuarial Society of Hong Kong (ASHK), was attended by 33 participants from 12 countries and was organized in two sessions. The morning session addressed presentations on the topic *The Future of Actuarial Work*. The afternoon session presented a workshop on the topic of the Professional Use of AI, showcasing a series of case scenarios shared by the Institute and Faculty and Actuaries to encourage discussions and engagement among participants.

This event was part of a series of activities that IAA President-Elect, Ms. Bozena Hinton, undertook to promote and support the actuarial profession in the region, including: meeting with the senior officers from the Board of the ASHK; meeting with professors from the Chinese University of Hong Kong Business School, and of The University of Hong Kong Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science.
